ABOUT OUR ONLINE GROUP SUPERVISION SERVICES

The Provisional Psychologist Network provides a range of online group supervision topics aimed at addressing the core competencies of the 4 + 2, 5 + 1 and registrar pathways. Annie Slater is a board approved supervisor who facilitates these group supervision sessions. She is also clinically endorsed.

Annie's groups are 2 hours in duration, and occur at 11am fortnightly on Thursdays. Groups have a maximum of five participants. Cost of group attendance is \$85 per hour per participant.

Please note that our appointments are set to Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) from the **first Sunday in October** to the **first Sunday in April** during Daylight Saving Time (DST) and Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) for the remainder of the year.

All groups are subject to change, and we require a minimum 3 participants attending to facilitate the group. We confirm groups one week prior. We do our best to market groups effectively to minimise the likelihood of groups being cancelled.

HOW TO ADD A SECONDARY SUPERVISOR TO ATTEND GROUPS

We can provide you with a signed secondary letter template for your supervisor to sign to send to AHPRA to add Annie to your plan (4 + 2 and 5 + 1 supervisees) or we can sign the forms to add to your registrar plan.

CANCELLATION POLICY

To prevent having to cancel groups at short notice, and ensure we are valuing the time spent preparing content/the time put aside to facilitate group supervision, the following cancellation policy applies.

All group supervision sessions will require at least seven days of notice of cancellation, otherwise a cancellation fee of the full cost of the group supervision session booked will be charged.

Cancellations for group supervision are required to be completed via the booking portal, or via email to contact@provisionalpsychologistnetwork.com. As a courtesy we may send you an SMS reminder for your scheduled group session two weeks prior, and the day prior. However, this is a courtesy service only and should we experience staff shortages or technical difficulties this may not occur. As such, it remains your responsibility to attend the session and the absence of an SMS reminder will not lead to cancellation fees being waived. We encourage everyone to check their diary and have a system in place for ensuring booked sessions are attended.

Group supervision sessions will continue to require a minimum of three participants go ahead. If the group needs to be cancelled for this reason any payment for the session will be fully refunded, and you will be notified a week prior to the group date.
